관광지 설명	전쟁기념관 The War Memorial of Korea	This is the only war memorial museum in Korea, and more than 9,000 war memorials are displayed in the exhibition room. In the war experience room, you can get a multi-sensory experience of the extreme reality of war, and reflect on the meaning of war that causes the division of Korea. You'll find so many things to see at Gwanghwamun Square, which was reborn on August 6 last year, as it was transformed into a public area that is more than twice as wide as before and now includes a park square.
	광화문광장 Gwanghwamun Square	Originally, Gwanghwamun Square was the site of major government offices during the Joseon Dynasty, and visitors can see the historical and cultural assets of both former and current government offices, while enjoying various attractions highlighting the achievements of King Sejong and Yi Sun-shin, Hallu content, and the works of new artists.
	중식 (국밥) Lunch (Gukbap)	One of the must-eat foods when visiting Korea as selected by CNN! Gukbap, a hot rice soup with generous servings of meat(pork), served in a milky broth and topped with sliced green onions, is a must-try dish that represents the unique taste of Korea. We especially recommend eating it with Kkakdugi , a kimchi dish made of radish, which is indispensable to the true Gukbap experience!
	덕수궁 Deoksugung Palace	Deoksugung Palace is a Joseon Dynasty-era palace that has been at the heart of every significant event since the establishment of Korea as a nation. It is the only palace in Seoul with a modern pavilion, a Western-style garden, and a fountain, and represents both the classical and modern eras of Korean history. The stone wall road along Deoksugung Palace has been selected as one of Korea's 100 most beautiful roads, and offers a different feeling in all four seasons. Let's take a walk by the stone wall for a while.
	남대문시장 Namdaemun Market	Namdaemun is the largest open market in Korea. The stalls that line its alleys sell a whole host of items, ranging from clothes and household goods to food.
Notice		Built in the 1970s, this overpass was reborn as a public walking path in 2017. It is full of flowers and trees, allowing you to feel the essence of nature in the city center, and a total of 17 walking paths are connected. Don't forget to take a picture of Seoul Station and the national treasure, Namdaemun Market, from the walking path! 1) Inclusion: English-speaking guide, transportation, travel insurance, admission fees, lunch 2) Exclusion: Personal expenses 3) June 6th is Memorial Day, a national holiday, and streets may be congested.

관광지 설명	임진각 평화누리 공원 Imjingak Pyeonghwa Nuri Park	Imjingak Pyeonghwa Nuri Park is a fascinating cultural complex. You can see various tourist attractions such as the Hill of the Wind, the Bridge of Liberty, the Mangbaedan, the Steam Locomotive, and an Underground bunker at the military facilities.
	DMZ (Demilitarized Zone)	The DMZ Tour is one of the most popular tourist destinations in the world and has been selected as a must-visit tourist destination when visiting Korea. The tour runs for about two and a half hours from the time you enter the Unification Bridge which is the only overland bridge to the Civilian Control Line and DMZ. And it offers visits to the Third Tunnel, Dora Observatory, where you can see North Korea, and local shops in Unification Village. Make sure you don't miss the lookout point where you can use binoculars from the Dora Observatory to get a detailed peek into North Korea! If you're lucky, you can even see North Korean farmers during the farming season!

Admission may be restricted without a passport. 4) Early departure is required as ticketing to the DMZ is processed on a first-come, first-served basis at the site, and the end time of the tour may be delayed depending on the order of admission.
